The ACA, Boar Swamp Campdraft Club Inc, and owners of the property do not accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to any horse, rider, beast, spectator or any other person or property whatsoever. As per the ACA Code of Conduct, a competitor shall accept and abide by the programme and requirements set by the ACA, Boar Swamp Campdraft Club Inc. and owners of the property. This includes (but is not limited to) the committee having the right to refuse nominations and on-site entry to individuals without explanation. By nominating in this event and/or entering the grounds, you are agreeing to abide by all conditions of entry.

#### **Nominations:**

Boar Swamp Campdraft is trialling Campdraft Central, an online nominating and payment portal:

- 1. Entries will open 7am Saturday 1st November 2014 and will close on or before Friday 14th November 2014.
- 2. Visit <a href="http://www.campdraftcentral.com.au">http://www.campdraftcentral.com.au</a> to login. Your Member Login is your ACA Membership # and Password (this can be found on your membership invoice or by contacting the ACA or Campdraft Central).
- 3. Follow the prompts to enter in the relevant events.
- 4. Entries will be processed in the order the entry and payment is received. Payment can be made by:
  - a. Direct Debit: Acc Name: Boar Swamp Campdraft Club Inc, BSB: 036 171, Acc No: 228 696; or
  - b. **Cheque** payable to **Boar Swamp Campdraft Club Inc** and sent to Annabel McLarty, Boar Swamp Campdraft, PO Box 41, PINJARRA WA 6208.
- 5. Strictly **no phone, faxed or emailed entries** will be accepted however in extenuating circumstances the Secretary can nominate for competitors.
- 6. Any changes to your nominations can be made online through the Campdraft Central portal. Please advise the Secretary of any changes made after 8am on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> November 2014.
- 7. You will be notified if you are on the waiting list and as positions become available.



#### CAMPDRAFTCENTRAL

#### **General ACA and Boar Swamp Campdraft Club Inc. Rules:**

- NCCA / ACA Rules apply to all Campdrafts.
- Competitors are entitled to a maximum of 8 first round starts.
- Winnings will be paid 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> place for Maiden, Novice, Open, Juvenile and Junior campdrafts and 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> for the Open Horse, Encouragement and Ladies Campdrafts in accordance with the ACA guidelines and rules.
- Stallions are permitted to be unrestrained in panel yards throughout daylight hours but **must** be double tied after dark. Only 1 horse is permitted per enclosure. Panels must be a minimum height of 1500mm and constructed using an equivalent of 4 bars of a minimum width of 25mm box/pipe equivalent. Panels must be securely anchored to a solid object (i.e. truck, post or tree). Junior and Juvenile age competitors are not permitted to handle or ride stallions whilst on the Boar Swamp Campdraft grounds.
- Junior age competitors may ride in Junior Campdraft events only.
- Juvenile age competitors may ride in all events except the Encouragement Campdraft.
- Riders under 18 years are to wear a correctly fitted helmet that complies with Industry and Sports Standards. All
  other riders are encouraged to also wear helmets.
- ACA Dress Code applies: Competitors to wear a helmet/hat, collared buttoned shirt, trousers and boots.
- The organising committee reserves the right to alter the programme at any time.
- Cattle and daylight hours are limited.

#### **ACA Membership:**

• ACA Membership renewals for 2014/15 were due **1st April 2014**. Any competitor or person intending to ride a horse on the Boar Swamp grounds (even if not competing) <u>must</u> be a fully financial ACA member. Memberships can be renewed online at <a href="http://www.campdraft.com.au">http://www.campdraft.com.au</a>.

#### **Programme Changes:**

- No refunds within 72 hours prior to 8am on the first morning of the programme, unless in the case of extenuating circumstances.
- Ensure that any horse/rider programme changes are made through the office prior to the commencement of each event. Changes made prior to 72 hours before the event can be made online through the Campdraft Central Portal.
- A horse's draw will not be altered unless the rider misses their run due to campdraft organisation commitments on the day. Any other horse that misses its draw will be moved to last, if time permits.

- Strictly NO hay to be brought onto the property.
- Lucerne hay bales will be available to purchase for \$17 per bale and must be pre-ordered on or before Friday 14

- Blythewood Pasture Hay (\$8) and Oaten Hay (\$10) will be available to purchase throughout the weekend.

- Watering points are provided. Bring your own fittings and hose/s.
